

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PERTH-ANDOVER

TO ALLOW THE NUMBERING OF PROPERTIES

The Council of the Municipality of Perth-Andover may number properties in accordance with the guidelines set forth, and hereby enacts as follows:

1. All properties containing a minimum frontage of 18.3 metres and fronting on a public street shall be allotted a number.
2. Properties accessed by more than one driveway shall derive the number from the main entrance or front door.
3. Streets shall be numbered with odd numbers to the left and even numbers to the right.
4. Perth Main Street shall be numbered, beginning at the south limit with #300, increasing to the north.
5. Andover Main Street shall be numbered, beginning at the south limit with #1000 increasing to the north.
6. Streets with an entrance at a provincial road shall be numbered with the smallest number at this junction.
7. Crescent streets shall be numbered starting at the most southerly intersection in the case of crescents intersecting north/south streets and starting at the most easterly intersection in the case of crescents intersecting east/west streets.
8. Streets not directly connected with a provincial street, shall be numbered starting at the end connected with the street that does so connect.
9. Cross Streets shall be numbered, generally starting at the south end, or at the east end in the case of east/west cross streets.
10. Generally, and notwithstanding the above, on the east side of the river, numbering shall increase to the east and on the west side of the river, increasing to the west and North South Streets shall increase in a northerly direction.
